Good afternoon Heather,

Thank you for your email, and I'm delighted to be able to confirm the donation of £400 that Cllr Shovelton proposed at the public meeting last week.

Councillors were keen to support schools and agreed to distribute part of its Covid-19 Community Fund for the benefit of pupils impacted by the current lockdown. As the councillor explained, the funding is allocated on the basis of the number of pupils attending your school who are resident in St Keyne, but councillors recognise that this money is not intended to be spent solely on them.

They need to see the funding used before the end of the current school year, and when this has been achieved, would appreciate knowing how it was spent and what positive outcomes were made. There is no need for a long or complex report, but an email explaining how the money was used will enable councillors to explain to their residents how their local tax has been spent.

I have set up the payment with our bank this afternoon. You should expect to receive the funds into your account by the end of the week. Please let me know when it has been safely received.
