Chair's Welcome & Housekeeping

The Chair welcomed residents to the meeting and thanked all her councillors for the support and hard work over the past year. The transcript of her report would be available from the council's website after this meeting. Minutes of the meeting held on 14 May 2019 were accepted. Proposed Mr Kevin Shovelton. Seconded Cllr Sally Lewis.

Her key points were

- To thank parish councillors and clerk who have taken on responsibilities above and beyond what would be expected of them.
- To thank Cornwall Councillors Jane Pascoe and Armand Toms, for their extra work supporting residents.
- Public meetings are now divided between the village halls at Trewidland and St Keyne – the council appreciates the interest that residents take in attending our meetings.
- Residents have continued to support each other during the Covid-19 lockdown, and we are all appreciative of their efforts.
- Continuing improvements in Jubilee Park and the Lawn Cemetery made by residents and the Garden Club are appreciated. The council is receiving tenders to build a new pathway in the cemetery to improve access.
- Defibrillator for Trewidland Village Hall has been ordered, and we are waiting for confirmation of delivery.
- Improvements in Trewidland requested by local residents have been delivered – a new community noticeboard, grit bin and warning notices for speeding vehicles have been installed.

Issues from residents

- Question on the removal of trees from private land. A number of young trees have been removed from a site in Trewidland. Is this legal or desirable? Cllr Toms to follow up.
- Mhairi Mackie presented a report from the Dobwalls & Trewidland Neighbourhood Plan Group and confirmed that the original development boundary would be maintained. Would welcome the opportunity to set up a Trewidland Greenspace group to take forward current NDP proposals.
